³ Includes ports where your shipment meets the criteria for the port to act as designated. These criteria can be found in 50 CFR § 14.16 (border ports and certain North American wildlife), § 14.17 (personally owned pet birds), § 14.18 (marine mammals), § 14.19 (special ports), § 14.22 (certain antique articles), and § 14.24 (scientific specimens). If your shipment meets the criteria to use the ports identified in the applicable regulation, the port is acting as a designated port for your shipment. If your shipment does not meet the criteria, the port is a non-designated port for your shipment.

⁴ Shipments are considered cargo if the mode of transport used is **other than** the mail, passenger travel, travel on foot, or the importer/exporter using their personal vehicle.
